Genesis Publishing Services (GPS) has created this privacy statement in order to demonstrate our commitment to privacy to our web hosting customers and users of this website.

This privacy policy governs the manner in which Genesis Publishing Services (GPS) uses, maintains and discloses information collected from its customers and users of its Website.

Privacy

GPS is committed to developing long lasting relationships based on trust. In furtherance of this goal, GPS will do everything in its power to ensure that your right to privacy is maintained and protected.

This Website is not directed at children under 13 years of age.

Information We Collect

GPS may request or collect personal information from online users in a variety of ways, including through online forms for ordering products and services, and other instances where users are invited to volunteer such information.

The information we collect is personal information that identifies you personally, such as:

- Your name
- E-mail address
- Postal address
- Telephone and fax numbers
- URL
- Credit card information
- Other billing information

GPS may also collect information about how users access the Website using a tracking ID unique to each user through the use of cookies. (Future application) Web Site Hosting info.

What are Cookies?

A cookie is a piece of data stored on the user's computer tied to information about the user. We may use both session ID cookies and persistent cookies. For session ID cookies, once you close your browser or log out, the cookie terminates and is erased. A persistent cookie is a small text file stored on your computer's hard drive for an extended period of time. Your browser's help file contains information and instructions for removing persistent cookies. Session ID cookies may be used by GPS to track user preferences while the user is visiting the website. They also help to minimize load times and save on server processing. Persistent cookies may be used by GPS to store whether, for example, you want your password remembered or not, and other information. Cookies used on the GPS Website do not contain personally identifiable information.

Log Files

Like most standard Websites, we use log files. This information may include internet protocol (IP) addresses, browser type, internet service provider (ISP), referring/exit pages, platform type, date/time stamp, and number of clicks to analyze trends, administer the site, track user's movement in the aggregate, and gather broad demographic information for aggregate use. However, none of the information stored in our log files, including but not limited to IP addresses, is linked to personally identifiable information

How we use this information

GPS may use the personally identifiable information collected by GPS to contact customers regarding products and services offered by GPS and, to the extent the User has agreed to it, by its trusted affiliates, independent

How we use this information

GPS may use the personally identifiable information collected by GPS to contact customers regarding products and services offered by GPS and, to the extent the User has agreed to it, by its trusted affiliates, independent contractors and business partners. We may also use this information for research purposes regarding the effectiveness of our Website services, marketing, advertising and sales efforts. GPS will not in any way share this information with a third party either for free or by selling it, unless you specifically authorize such disclosures.

Disclosure of Information

GPS may also disclose aggregate, anonymous, data based on information collected from Users to investors and potential partners. In such cases, statistical information only will be disclosed and personally identifiable data will be kept strictly confidential. In case GPS is sold, the information collected from users may be transferred to the new owners if required to continue their hosting services.

GPS may from time to time engage third parties, including its own subsidiaries and affiliated companies, to preserve, analyze or otherwise store or manipulate data received by GPS from its customers. In all such cases, such third party service providers will be required to treat all such data with the same degree of care as GPS and they will be prohibited from disclosing such data to any other person or party, except as otherwise provided for in this Privacy Policy.

Special Offers and Updates

Our customers and users will occasionally receive information on products, services, special deals, and possibly a newsletter. Out of respect for the privacy of our users we present the option to not receive these types of communications.

Service Announcements

On rare occasions it is necessary to send out a strictly service related announcement, if, for instance, our service is temporarily suspended for maintenance. Generally, users may not opt-out of these communications, though they can deactivate their account. However, these communications are not promotional in nature.

Legal Disclaimer

Though we make every effort to preserve your privacy, we may need to disclose personal information when required by law, if we have a good-faith belief that such action is necessary and required to comply with a current judicial proceeding, a court order or legal process served on GPS .

The GPS Websites contains links to other sites. Please be aware that GPS is not responsible for the privacy practices of such other sites. We encourage you to read the privacy statements of each and every Web site that collects personally identifiable information. The GPS Privacy Policy as described herein applies solely to information collected by GPS .

Maintenance of Information

The information provided to GPS is saved indefinitely and may be stored on one or more databases directly or indirectly maintained by GPS . GPS employs industry standard security measures to protect the confidentiality of the information. While we cannot guarantee that loss, misuse or alteration to data will not occur; we make every effort to prevent such occurrences. Any other particularly sensitive information, such as credit card numbers collected for commercial transactions, is encrypted prior to transmission by you to GPS.

Your Responsibility

You are responsible for the security of your Customer ID and passwords. Make sure you keep it in a safe place and do not share it with others. Always remember to log out after your session ends, to ensure that others cannot access your private personal information. You should take this precaution even if you are not using a public computer, such as at a library or internet café, but even when using your private computer in your home.
